EXTENSION ACTIVITY BY FINE ARTS ASSOCIATION



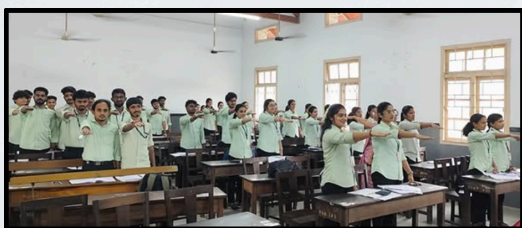

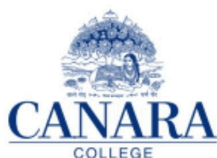
