National Level Panel Discussion

A total of 22 students and 4 staff members participated in that panel discussion on “From Science to Society: Scalable Solutions for Clean Water.”



DEPARTMENT OF CHEMISTRY

“CATCH THEM YOUNG”: An Outreach Programme

“Catch them Young” is an outreach programme aimed to engage and inspire high school students around Mangalore by demonstrating fascinating chemistry experiments. The Programme was organized on January 16-17, 2025, for III BSc students. This initiative sought to enhance students’ interest in chemistry and broaden their understanding of chemical concepts through hands-on learning experiences. Thirteen chemistry students visited four schools in two different schools around Mangalore and demonstrated chemistry experiments to high school students.





Concept Test in Chemistry (CONTECH 2024-25 2nd Phase) Exam

The Association of Chemistry Teachers (ACT), Mumbai, in collaboration with the Homi Bhabha Centre for Science Education, Mumbai, has been organizing the Concept Test in Chemistry (CONTECH) since 2010 to evaluate the conceptual understanding of undergraduate chemistry students across the nation. This year, the second phase of CONTECH was scheduled for March 22, 2025, from 11:00 AM to 1:00 PM. Out of 39 students, 31 students cleared the exam by securing above 30%, and 3 students scored above 60%, and they will receive certificates from the Association of Chemistry Teachers (ACT), Mumbai.



Industrial Visit

A one-day industrial visit was organized for second- and final-year B.Sc. Chemistry students on April 19, 2025, to industrial units located in and around Kulshekara and Baikampady. These visits aim to expose students to real-world industrial environments, helping them understand processes, operations, and technologies used in sectors such as manufacturing, engineering, and production.

Educational Visit to the Math Lab at Nada, Belthangady

A group of final-year and second-year Mathematics students visited the Basic Math Lab at Government School, Nada, Belthangady, on March 6, 2025. The lab, established in 2015 by Mr. Yakub Koyyuru, a Mathematics teacher who received the National Award from the Union Ministry of Education in 2020 for his innovative initiative, helps students visualize and understand mathematical concepts through the use of real models.

Session on Interview Skills



Poster Contest on International Women's Day- 2025






Emotional and Mental Readiness at Workplace
